In contrast to 2-year or 4-year colleges that typically include general education courses like English or Biology, trade school programs focus exclusively on relevant job training.

Trade Schools encompass a wide range of disciplines, including but not limited to Construction (Labors, Equipment Operators, and Carpentry), CDL Training, Computer Information Systems/IT, Cosmetology, Criminal Justice, Culinary Arts, Electrical, HVAC, Mechanic/Auto Mechanic, Medical Assisting, Welding, and Wellness/Massage. The Cavanaugh Building Corporation Trade School Scholarship strives to empower students pursuing excellence in these hands-on and practical career paths.

Requirements

The Cavanaugh Building Corporation Trade School Scholarship is a non-renewable award of \$1,000 for one year. This scholarship is intended to be disbursed directly to the student, facilitating the acquisition of essential tools and equipment required to commence their education at a trade school.
